

The SERMON on the MOUNT

Compiled by Bruce T. Forbes; copyright 1998

Scholars believe this discourse was delivered in the first part of Christ's ministry, and it expresses many of the basic teachings that would begin to turn the people from the basics of the Law of Moses and point them toward the Gospel of Christ.

Even between the two Matthew versions there are significant difference - one of the main ones being that the JST leaves the impression that this sermon was given to his immediate followers the Twelve, and they in turn disseminated throughout the church those portions not meant specifically for the Twelve.

Roughly four years after the original discourse, this was delivered by the Resurrected Christ in the New World. Being a different culture who did not know what Pharisees or Sadducees or even pennies were, there are cultural differences in the Nephite version. Additionally, with the Nephite version being delivered after Christ's death and Resurrection - and after the Atonement - He had fulfilled and completed The Law when it was given - hence references to the fulfillment of the Law are past tense as opposed to future tense as in the Matthew versions.
